

**Green Hammerton, Playing Fields, Children's Playground and Village Hall,
Transport & Parking Policy.**

The Playing Fields, Children's Playground and Village Hall exist for the benefit of residents of Green Hammerton, and it is important we do not inconvenience them.

If attending the facilities by car, there is limited parking for playing fields, playground and village hall, and we encourage the car park to be used whenever possible.

We advise local users to walk to the facilities; there is a pedestrian entrance on Boroughbridge Road and two pedestrian and disabled entrances on Harrogate Road.

If coming by **rail**, Hammerton station is within an easy mile walk from Green Hammerton.

Green Hammerton is serviced by 82 **bus** route and it is just a short walk from the bus stop.

Parking is important to us, for the safety of all.

Please car share whenever possible.

If arriving by **car** please park in the designated car park, there is parking for approx. 25 vehicles. If the car park is full we ask you to respect our neighbours and park with consideration to others.

Harrogate Road gets very congested, please park on the left as entering the village and leave crossing and passing points, where there is a dropped kerb on the right and at the pedestrian entrance on the east side of the park, to enable cars to get out of the junction and pedestrians to cross the road safely.

Please do not park on verges or kerbing.

Please do not park on the junctions, or cause inconvenience to the residents of Green Hammerton by parking over or opposite their drives, as this inhibits their ability to reverse out of their drives. There have been incidences of cars being damaged by residents trying to get out of their drives.

Please do not park within 20 metres of the junctions on Harrogate Road and Boroughbridge Road to allow traffic to have full visibility of oncoming cars when turning onto the B6265.

If it is expected that if an event is going to exceed the parking capacity, an event specific parking plan will be produced and agreed, this will include the use of Traffic Marshalls and parking cones.
